- Provide Exceptional Patient Care: Safely handle and restrain horses of all ages and temperaments, from foals to racehorses and neurologic cases, during exams, diagnostics, and emergencies.
- Support Our Medicine Team: Assist clinicians and interns with outpatients, farm calls, in-hospital procedures, and emergency cases while ensuring accurate medical documentation.
- Prepare and Assist with Procedures: Set up, assist, and clean up for all patient procedures using proper aseptic technique; help with imaging, MRIs, myelograms, and other diagnostics.
- Work Hands-On with Samples: Collect and process lab samples (blood, feces, urine, CSF, etc.) for in-house and outside laboratory testing.
- Use Your Technical Skills: Place IV catheters, take diagnostic radiographs, and assist with transfusions and donor sample preparation.
